Attendees should be able to dedicate the entire 3 days and nights to fellowship, sharing and learning. Arrival, registration, and settling into dorms begins at 4:30 pm on Thursday afternoon. Events on Thursday begin with supper, promptly served at 5:30 pm followed by a full compliment of evening activities. All day Friday and Saturday are dedicated to teachings, activities and fellowship. Sunday continues with half-day activities terminating at 2:30 pm.

Full Weekend Participation

Part-time participation will not yield full benefit of the purpose for the retreat. We strongly recommend only full-time participation and therefore request all interested participants to clear their schedule so they will not be distracted between Thursday’s arrival and Sunday’s departure. Do not bring distractions to this weekend such as electronic devices which would otherwise occupy your attention and focus on God.

Location

Bob White group camping area is located at Knob Noster State Park in Knob Noster, Missouri. Knob Noster State Park is approximately 75 miles east of downtown Kansas City, Missouri. The park’s 3,934 acres contain a mixture of prairie, savanna and forest. The setting is excellent for renewal and meditation on our personal relationship with God.

Directions

Take I-70 east or take Hwy 50 east to MO-13 toward Warrensburg. Continue south on 13 through Warrensburg to Hwy DD. Turn east on DD, continue to Knob Noster State Park. As soon as you enter the state park, you will see a sign for Camp Bob White, turn right (south) into the camp and follow the road to the dining hall parking lot.

Facilities

Bob White is a semi-rustic group camping area with cabins arranged in a dormitory style setting. (Semi-rustic denotes that there is no room service, no carpeted floors, and no housekeeping staff to cater to patron’s needs.) Bunk beds and bathrooms are located in the dorms which accommodate single gender residency. Attendees will be required to bring their own bedding. For those attendees who require bedding please make note in your registration form or contact the registrar. Feel free to bring a space heater. The facilities provide an atmosphere to commune with God, friendships to develop, and intimate discussions to be held among participants.

Attire

Attire for the weekend is casual and comfortable. April and May in Missouri may feel colder to those who live in southern climates. Bring long sleeves and jackets. It is better to dress in layers. As weather permits, we will hold some of our activities outside. This time of year may also be breezy or rainy. Sturdy shoes that work well in wet weather and mud are advisable. Bring warm bedding such as sleeping bag and blanket.

Meals

Experienced personnel will prepare the meals and menus. Food will be wholesome and appetizing with a salad bar provided at every meal. Contact the registrar for questions about the menus or for special dietary needs.

Cost

\$125.00 per person or \$175.00 per couple for the weekend retreat includes meals and lodging paid 2 weeks prior to the retreat. Late registrations received less than 2 weeks prior to the start of the retreat or at arrival will require an additional \$25 charge per person to cover unplanned food expense.
