

Directions to Camp Shawnee in Knob Noster State Park:

Take I-70 east to MO-13 toward Warrensburg. Continue south on 13 through Warrensburg to Hwy DD. Turn east on DD, continue to Knob Noster State Park. There will be a sign for Camp Shawnee, turn left (north) into the camp and follow the road to the dining hall parking lot.
